Preaching the Truth in Love!

Contend for the Faith

Jude admonishes Christians to contend for the faith (Jude 3). He does not leave us to guess as to why there is such a necessity because in the very next verse of scripture he tells us: "For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ." However many in the Lord's body would say that it is unloving and not Christ-like to contend for the faith. The Christian should always be kind and considerate. But being kind and standing up for the truth and against false teaching are not mutually exclusive. Furthermore, it is the teaching we aught oppose not the persons espousing such erroneous doctrine. Too often there are those that will gladly compromise the truth and will be able to "agree to disagree" on doctrinal issues. Notice several examples of those in the New Testament that defended the truth.

1. Jesus is the world's greatest controversial figure. It follows that since we are to follow in His steps (1 Peter 2:21), and since He publicly defended the truth, we likewise must do the same.

There can be no doubt that He loved everyone - He died for them! But not once did He endorse the false doctrine or those teaching it in His day (Matthew 15:9; 23:1-39).

- .2. Peter and John earnestly contended for the faith as recorded in the Acts 4 & 5. far from being the only members of the church to do so, the whole church was set for the defense of the Gospel (1 Peter 3:15). The early churdh was constantly challenged by the enemies of the truth, especially those of Judaism.
- 3. Stephen was a man filled with the Holy Ghost. He courageously defended the truth in public and the result was that He was stoned to death. The Lord showed His approval from Heaven by standing up at the right hand of the Throne (Acts 7:55,56). After reading Acts chapter 7, Stephen was bold in his proclamation, but he was not unloving nor unkind. Therefore, when Sptephen requested the Lord to receive his spirit the Savior did just that (Acts 7:59,60).
- 4. The Apostle Paul was one that filled his life by contending for the faith. Everywhere he went there was some sort of opposition. Certainly there were those that listened to the pure Gospel of Jesus the Christ. Those that listened and obeyed were saved. Those that opposed Paul and the Gospel were not saved (Mark 16:16). Paul preached the truth fervently because he knew its power (Hebrews 4:12). When his preaching sparked a debate or some controversy, he took advantage of the situation by preaching and teaching the truth and refuting error.

In all these things the reason we contend for the faith is so that some will be saved and that all might have an opportunity to hear the truth and make their own decision to follow the Lord.
