A Whale of a Tale

It takes an enormous amount of [blind] faith, as well as downright gullibility, to believe in Charles Darwin's General Theory of Evolution. He maintained that a lower species of plant or animal life can, over a period of millions of years, evolve into another species of a plant or animal.

Yet, contrary to what evolutionists believe and assert, their theory has never been demonstrated by valid experimentation, observation in nature, or even in the fossil record. mouths, till a creature was produced as monstrous as a whale" (567).

So bizarre and ridiculous were his assumptions thought to be that he was forced to remove them from subsequent editions of his book by his scientific colleagues. Yet, is not the whole ungodly theory of evolution preposterous and ridiculous? "The fool hath said in his heart, 'There is no God'" (Psalm 14:1).

Today, Darwin's disciples have changed the bear-to-whale fiasco a little bit. Some maintain that whales evolved from a wolf-like creature or maybe a cat-like animal or perhaps a hippopotamus-like animal. Lately, some have fantasized over a deer-like creature. These experts all bicker among themselves over their outlandish speculations.

The Christians' faith is based on the inerrant word of God. On the fifth day of Creation the Bible records the creation of this enormous, beautifully complex creature, the whale.

"And God created **great whales**, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, **after their kind**, and every winged fowl **after his kind**: and God saw that it was good. And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let fowl multiply in the earth" (Genesis 1:21-22). [emp. mine - BTH]
