In a worship service, members and friends gather together, one man preaches while all others sit and listen. God seeks for hearers who listen. Just as there is a responsibility on the proclaimer of the Word, there is equally a responsibility to the hearer of it as well. Generally speaking there are four kinds of hearers in the assembly:

SPONGES. Sponges soak up everything that comes along. These hearers listen, read, and accumulate notes and facts. They are then able to become “walking Encyclopedias.” Sponges are curious and technical in their knowledge and typically enjoy discussing things they heard or learned. But they neither change nor apply what they have “soaked up.” So they know everything and nothing at the same time.

FUNNELS. These hearers allow truth to go in one ear and out the other. They tune out the unwanted, undesired, or demanding please of the preacher and Scripture. They become angry and defensive when told things they do not wish to hear or know. With all that passes through their ears, none of it sticks!

STRAINERS. These are the ones that listen to criticize. “The preacher said this,” “the preacher said it like that.” And since the preacher does not measure up to expectations (and he never will) the strainer has no obligation to obey the Word.

SIFTERS. These hearers are explorers, seekers, and hunters of great treasure! They “wade through” all the chaff and find those great pearls of wisdom. They are wise and seek after the wisdom of God’s word in spite of the preacher’s or their own imperfections. They then apply those found golden nuggets to their lives, and they are enriched!
