How Would YOU Answer?

"But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear" (I Peter 3:15 NKJV)

Peter was writing to Christians who were living in perilous times and facing persecution because of their faith. He wanted them to be able to stand firm, unwavering in the face of such suffering.

But the principle applies to us today. Why do we believe what we believe? Are we able to answer those who inquire about our beliefs?

> Why do I belong to a particular church? What did I do to become a member? Why do I worship the way I do? Why do I not practice certain things in worship that others practice? What did I do to be saved?

These are all teaching opportunities when we are questioned. Peter tells us how to respond:

- 1. Having sanctified the Lord God in our hearts, that is with an attitude of utmost reverence. If we have made Him # 1 in our lives, how can we teach others to do so?
- 2. Always be ready- Always willing and able at every opportunity.
- **3. To give a defense** ("answer" some versions). If we deny Him before men, Christ will deny us before His Father in heaven (Matthew 10:33-34).
- **4. To everyone** We must fear God who is able to destroy both body and soul in hell, rather than man who can kill the body but not the soul (Matthew 10:28).
- 5. That asks a reason for the hope that is in you. Our attitude ought to be, "People have a right to ask, and I have a responsibility to answer". What a great opportunity to teach them God's plan of salvation and what it has to offer those who respond to the Lord's invitation.
- **6. With meekness and fear.** We must be gentle and kind and always reverent with God's word.
