God's law was an expression of God's love and concern for the nation. Every demand and prohibition was penned in their best interest. They cry with ancient Judah, "speak unto us smooth things" (Isa. 30:10).

The church is replete with people who want religion without sacrifice, grace without law and Christ without a cross. Thus, they view the restricting, demanding, prohibiting will of God with disdain. Like the apostate heirs of Sinai, "they despise the law of the Lord" (Amos 2:4).

There is a "famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord" (Amos 8:11). Human interest stories, philosophy and personal experiences are serving as empty substitutes for a "thus saith God." Bible-centered preaching has become a lost art in many pulpits.
