A Prayer for Mercy

1 O LORD, do not rebuke me in Your anger, Nor chasten me in Your hot displeasure. 2 Have mercy on me, O LORD, for I am weak; O LORD, heal me, for my bones are troubled. 3 My soul also is greatly troubled; But You, O LORD—how long? 4 Return, O LORD, deliver me! Oh, save me for Your mercies' sake! 5 For in death there is no remembrance of You; In the grave who will give You thanks? 6 I am weary with my groaning; All night I make my bed swim; I drench my couch with my tears. 7 My eve wastes away because of grief; It grows old because of all my enemies. 8 Depart from me, all vou workers of iniquity: For the LORD has heard the voice of my weeping. 9 The LORD has heard my supplication; The LORD will receive my prayer. 10 Let all my enemies be ashamed and greatly troubled: Let them turn back and be ashamed suddenly. Psalm 6:1-10

Psalm 6 is the first of several penitent songs penned by King David. This prayer issued forth from a heart sick and sorrowful after a Godly sort for his own sins. David's personal sins broke his heart, but also the sins of others hurt him as well. He prayed to God that He would return to him. He prayed that God would hear his penance and answer his prayers. God did answer his prayers and gave David courage to stand before his enemies.

Sin is opposed to the will of God and is against His very nature. Sin is anything falling short of God's established standard which is perfection. The Bible declares that God is angry with the wicked. God is a just judge, and God is angry with the wicked every day" (Psalm 7:1).

When David asked God to return to him, he was asking God to renew His blessing upon him. David's prayer to God was, "Return, O Lord, deliver me! O save me for Your mercies sake!" We learn from David to place our worries in God's care. Much of David's sorrow and many of his tears were brought on by his enemies. When all was right between God and David, God was able to bless him and see that his enemies were brought to nothing and their schemes were thwarted.

God answered David's prayers and gave him courage to oppose his enemies. David said, "Depart from me, all you workers of iniquity; For the Lord has heard the voice of my weeping." When a person is righteous, God knows him and answers his prayers. God answered many of David's prayers because he was in a right relationship with Him.
