Mark 16:1-7

- ▶ He is the author of salvation – Heb 5:8-9
- ▶ God does not force any to keep this appointment – Ecc 11:9
- ▶ This appointment is at baptism – 1 Pet 3:21

SALVATION TO THE OBEDIENT

- ▶ The Christian should not neglect this appointment – Heb 10:25
- ▶ Paul postponed his journey to worship with the brethren – Acts 20:6,7

ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK

- ▶ A time appointed to remember the king – Luk 22:29-30
- ▶ Every first day of the week – Acts 20:7

THE LORD'S SUPPER

- ▶ As God has prospered – 1 Cor 16:2
- ▶ All are expected to give something
– Luke 21

GIVING AS PROSPERED

- ▶ Devoted prayer should start in secret – Mat 6:6
- ▶ The righteous have this appointment all the time – Jam 5:16; 1 The 5:17

PRAYING IN SECRET

- ▶ Obedience to Christ is necessary – Luk 6:46
- ▶ Choose to overcome and not be overcome by sin – 1 Cor 10:13

A CHRISTIAN LIFE

- ▶ This can be kept only once – Heb 9:27
- ▶ All will have this appointment – 1 Kings 2:2

AT DEATH

- ▶ Jesus will judge the world – Acts 17:31
- ▶ All created beings will be at this appointment – Rev 20:12-15
