- We do not do things to be seen – Matt 6:1,2
- We are to let our lights shine – Mat 5:13-16

# AUDIENCE OF PRAYER

- Daniel did not adopt the Babylonian or Persian gods – Dan 1:8
- Daniel prayed toward the Temple in Jerusalem – 1 Kin 8:28-30
- We pray to the Father through the Son – 1 Tim 2:5

# ATTITUDE OF PRAYER

- Daniel developed a habit of posture – Dan 6:10
- Contrast the Pharisee and the Publican – Luke 18:10-14
- Some healthy fear is good for us – Acts 8:24

# ASPECTS OF PRAYER

- He gave thanks – Col 3:17
- He relied on God as his help – vs 11; Phil 4:6
- This was a constant and consistent part of life – 1 The 5:17
