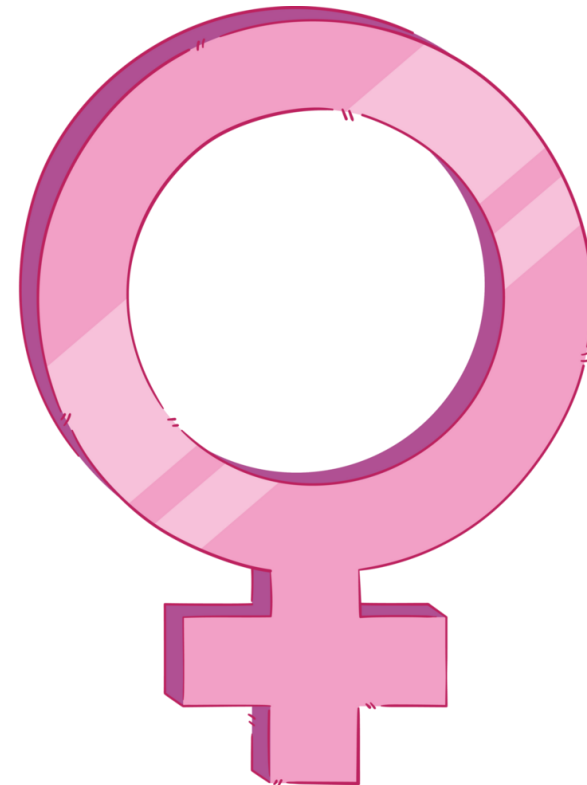


Women's Roles in the Church

1 Timothy 2:12

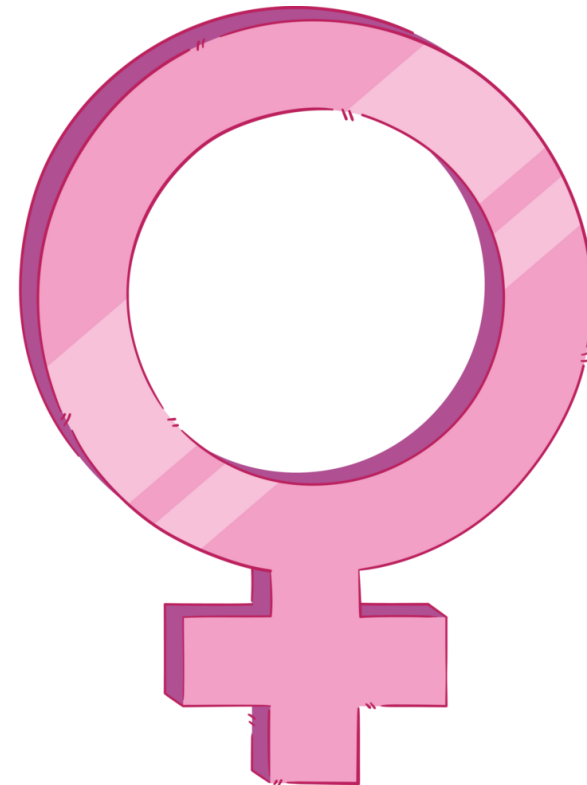
Feminist Movement in Churches

- January 23, 1955, the Presbyterian church voted to allow women to be ministers.
- May 4, 1956, the Methodist General Conference voted to allow ordination of women clergy.
- 1969 the Evangelical Lutheran Church voted to ordain women as full clergy members.
- 1972, 1974, & 1985 the three main sects of Judaism ordained women as rabbis



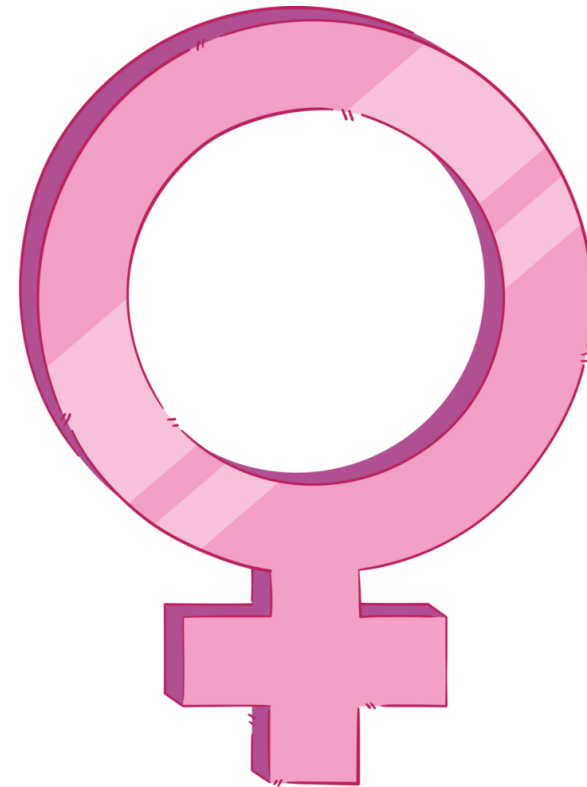
Teachers
